



Historic Bridge Restoration Project FUNDING UPDATE



Efforts are underway to raise the necessary matching funds in the amount of \$170,000, representing the 6.77% match for federal funds allocated to the project. Currently, Rockville has raised approximately \$35,000 of that amount in donations and fundraising efforts. This leaves approximately \$129,450 yet to raise by October 2017.

This is a one-time ask to the citizens of Rockville to partner with the Town in the restoration of this historic structure. **We are asking every household and property owner to go on record with his or her contributions.** In our requests to larger funding sources, we would like to show 100% participation from our citizens. We know you care about this community and the historical significance of our beautiful Bridge.

You may have given via the making of or purchase of artwork, dropping change in a donation jar, donated time or service, or bought merchandise such as a hat, tee shirt or mug. You may have been waiting to make your donation. **The time to support the Historic Rockville Bridge is now, before the end of the year.** We have a fundraising plan and timetable in place, but know that without individual support, the Town may have to carry an additional burden in the future.

You can mail in your contribution by check. Or you can stop by the Town offices (9am-1pm weekdays) and make your contribution in person. **Please stretch your donation to the maximum level of comfort; again, this is a one-time ask.** You will be given a receipt of your efforts for tax purposes, written recognition in all donor lists, and the personal knowledge that you have helped Rockville show close to 100% citizen participation in this campaign.
