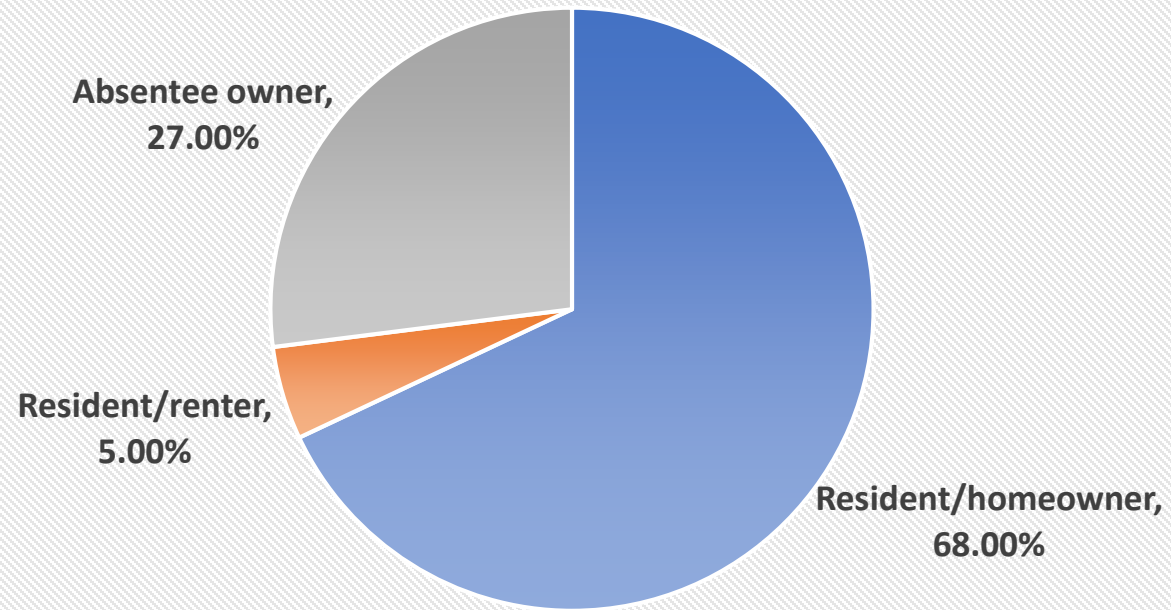

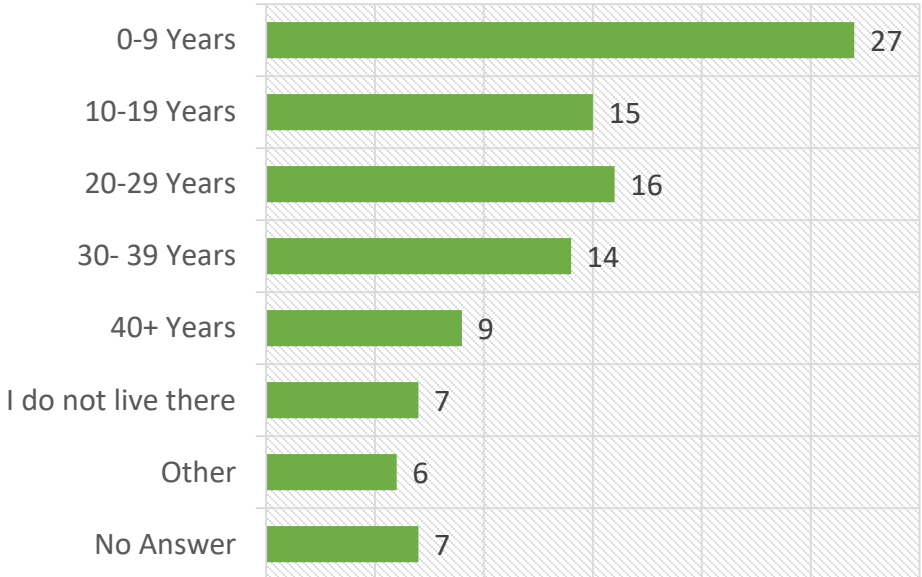

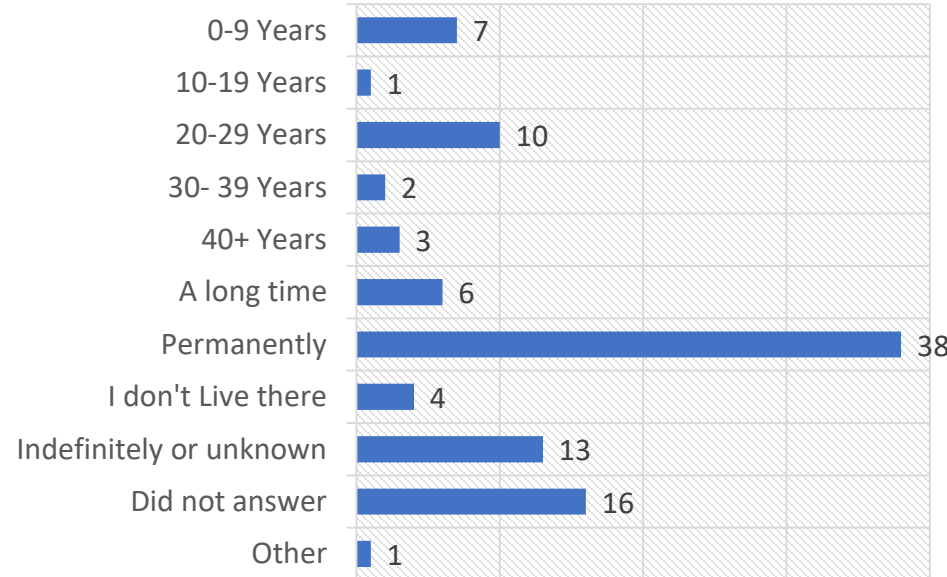
# Living in Rockville

94 answered 7 skipped

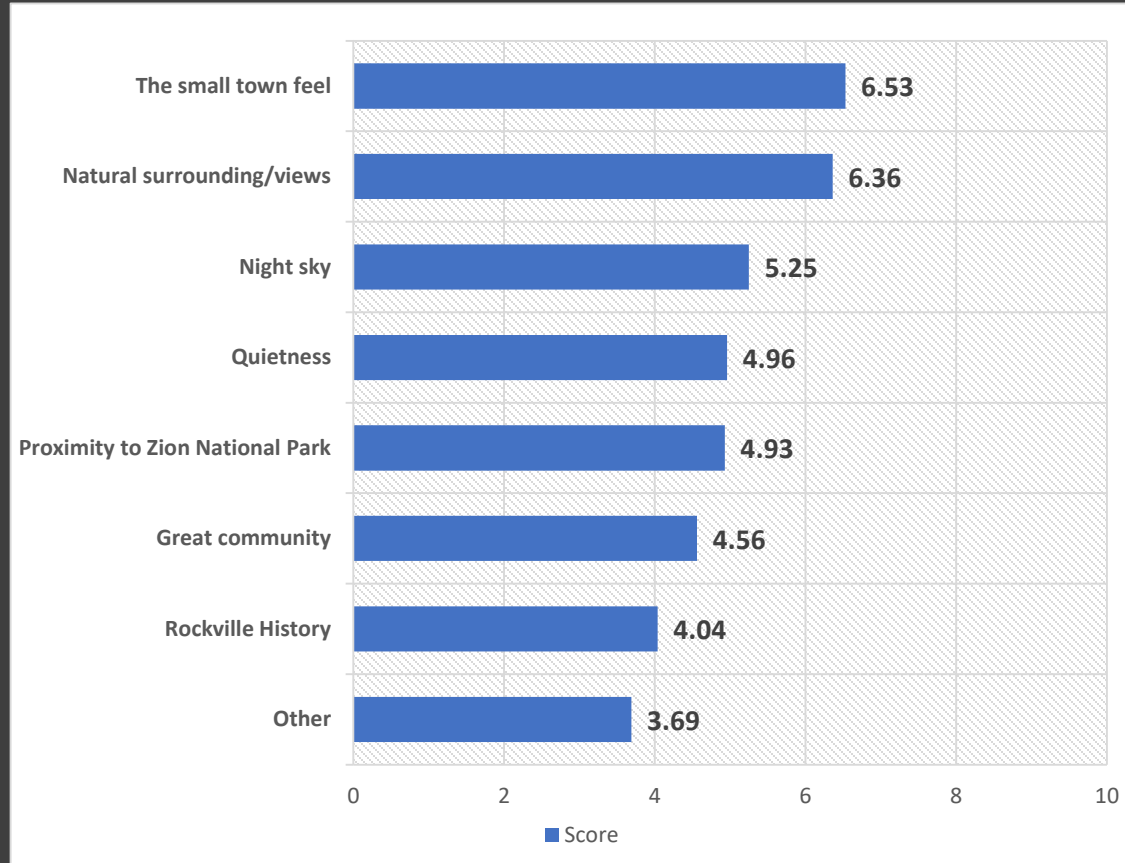
### How Long do you Plan to Live in Rockville?

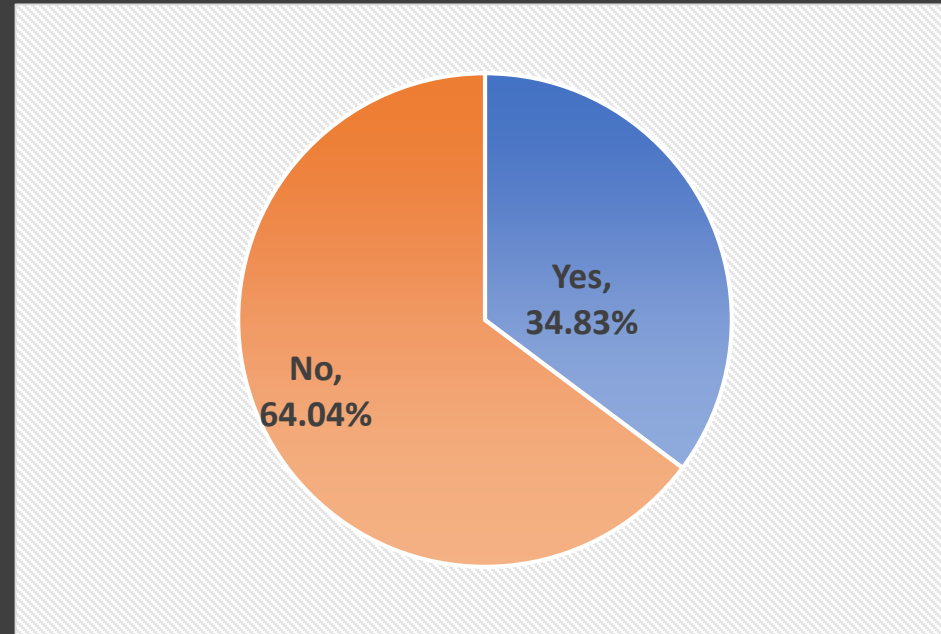

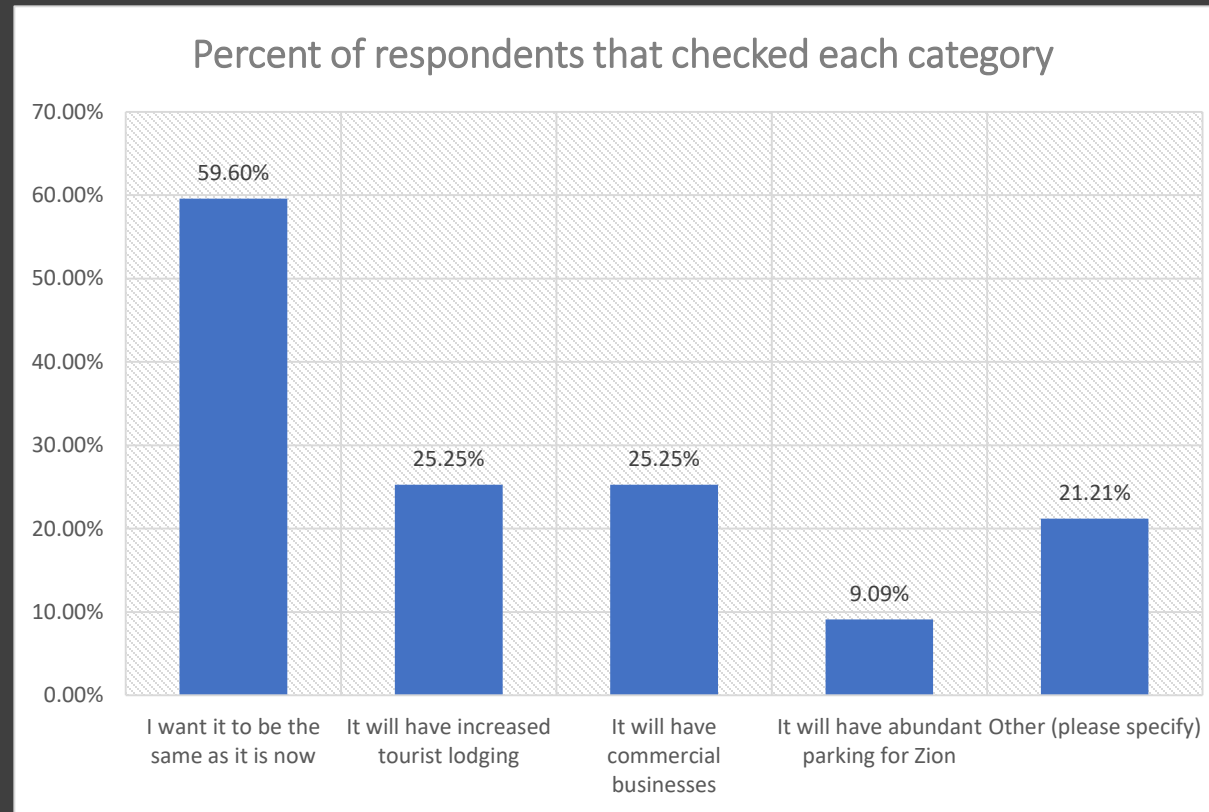


# What do you think will be Rockville's biggest challenge in the future?

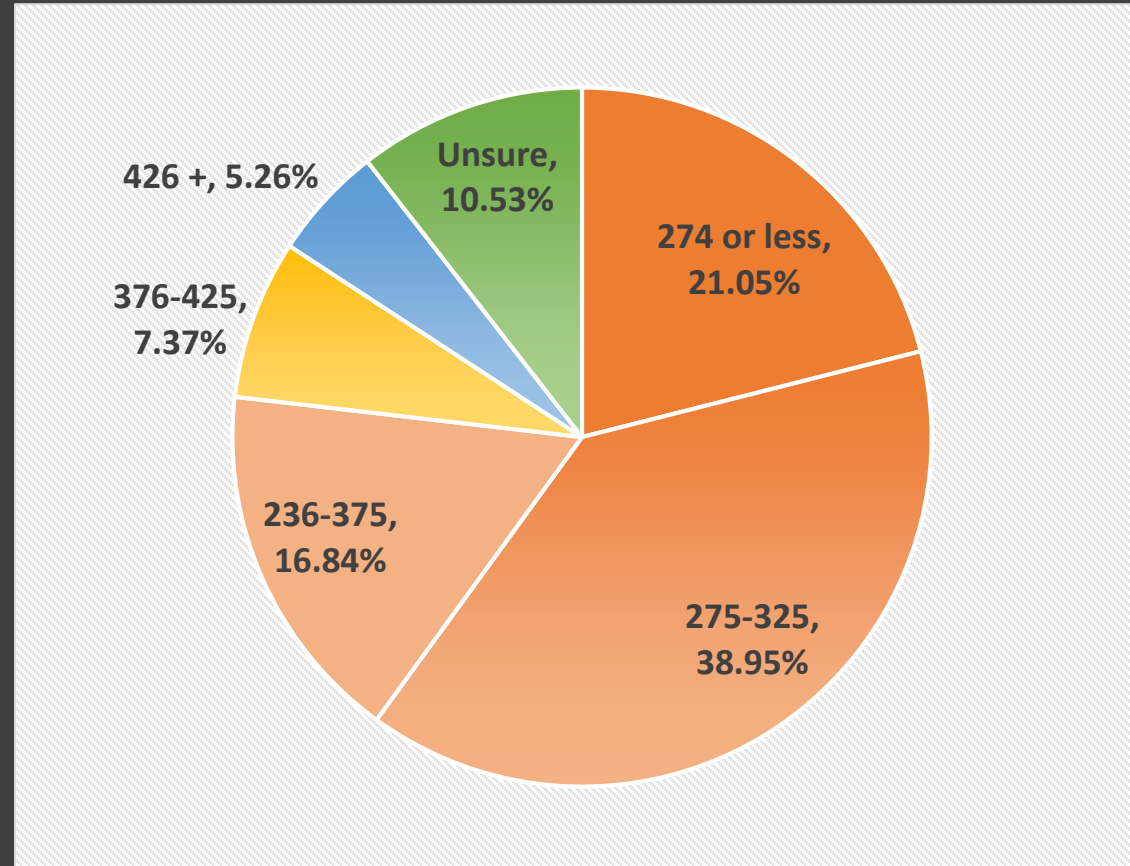

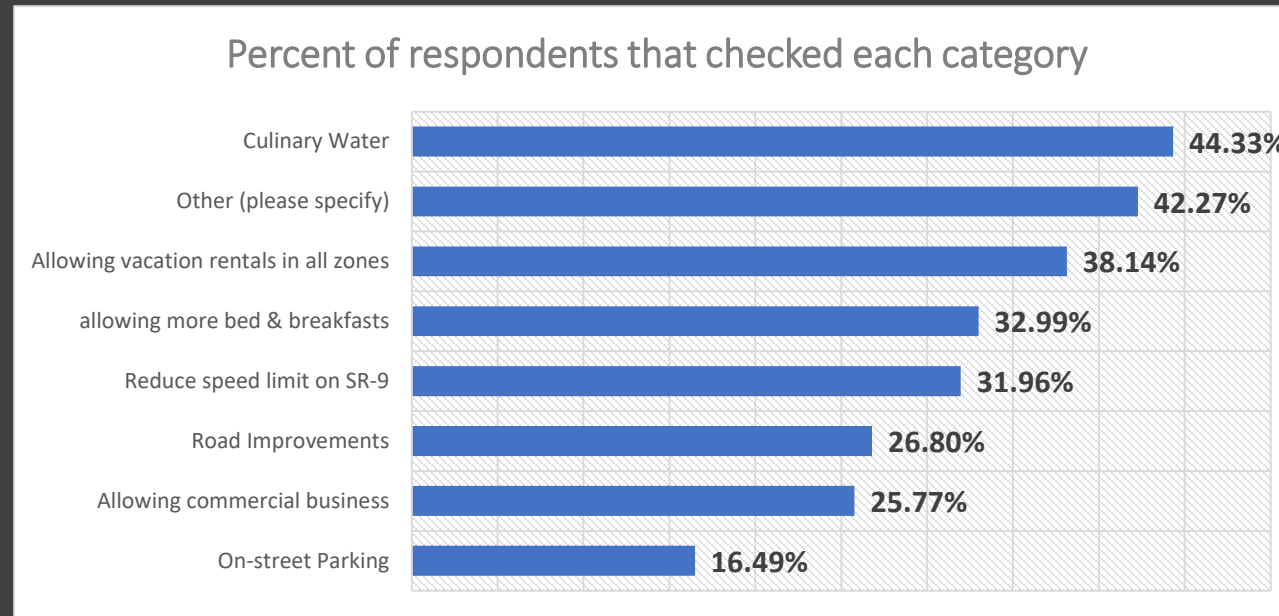
# What do you desire Rockville to be like five years from now?



# What do you believe an ideal population for the town will be in 10 years? (current population = 275)

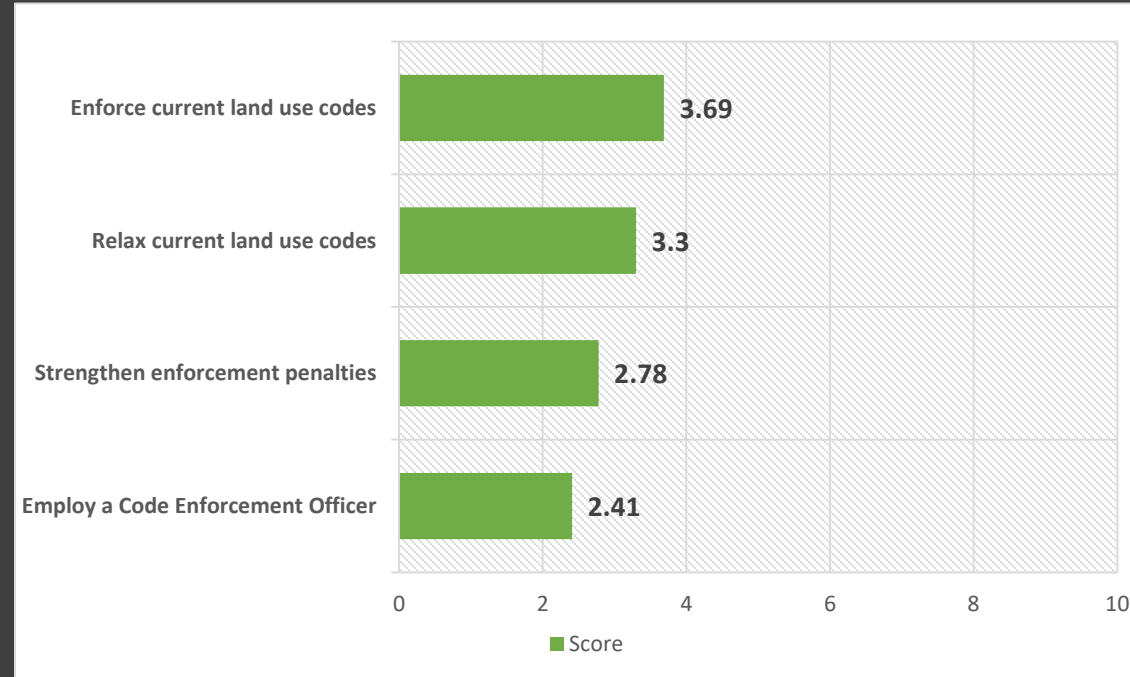


# Which, if any, issues would you like to see addressed by Town Officials?



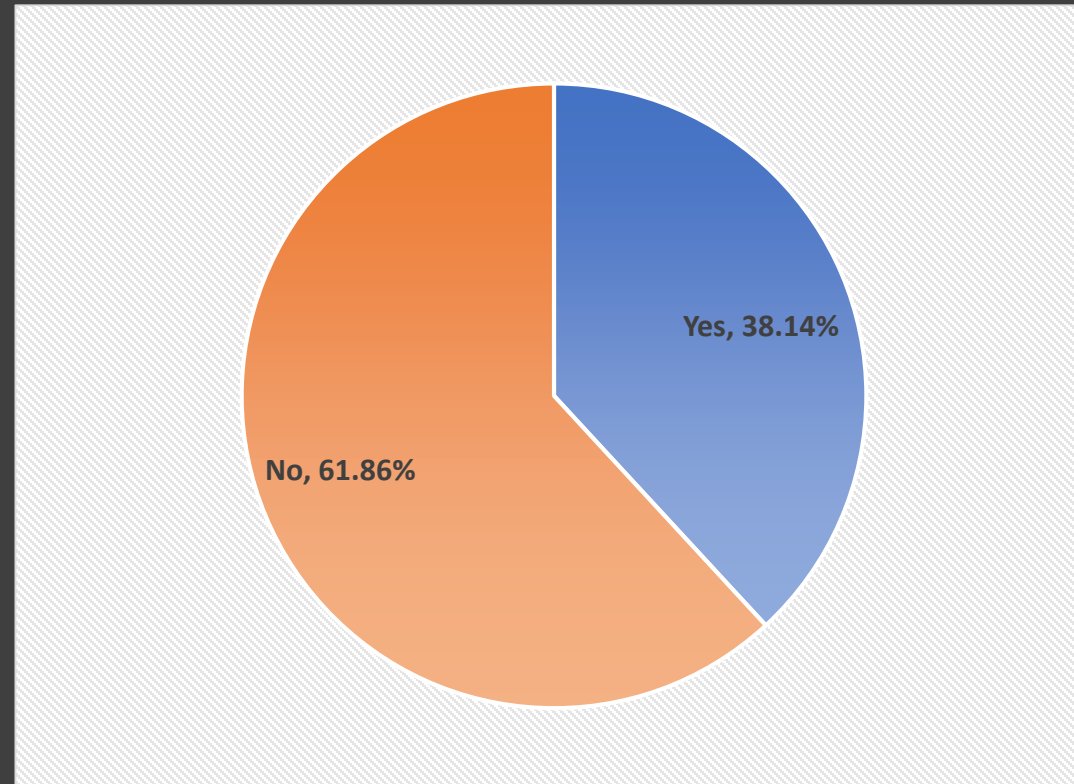

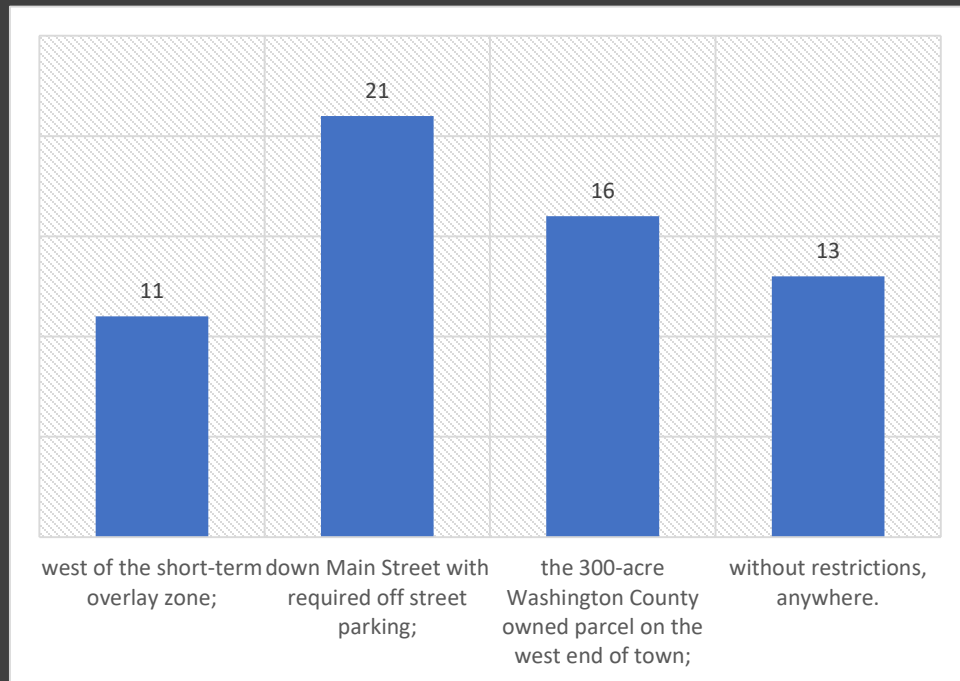

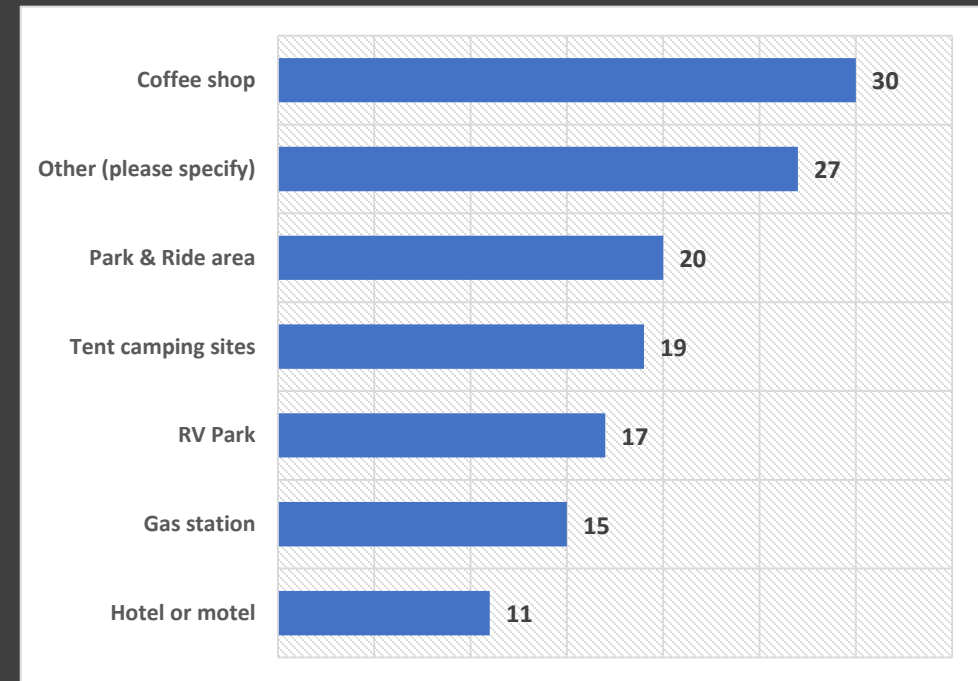
# Would you like commercial development in town?



# If you want commercial development, where would you like it?

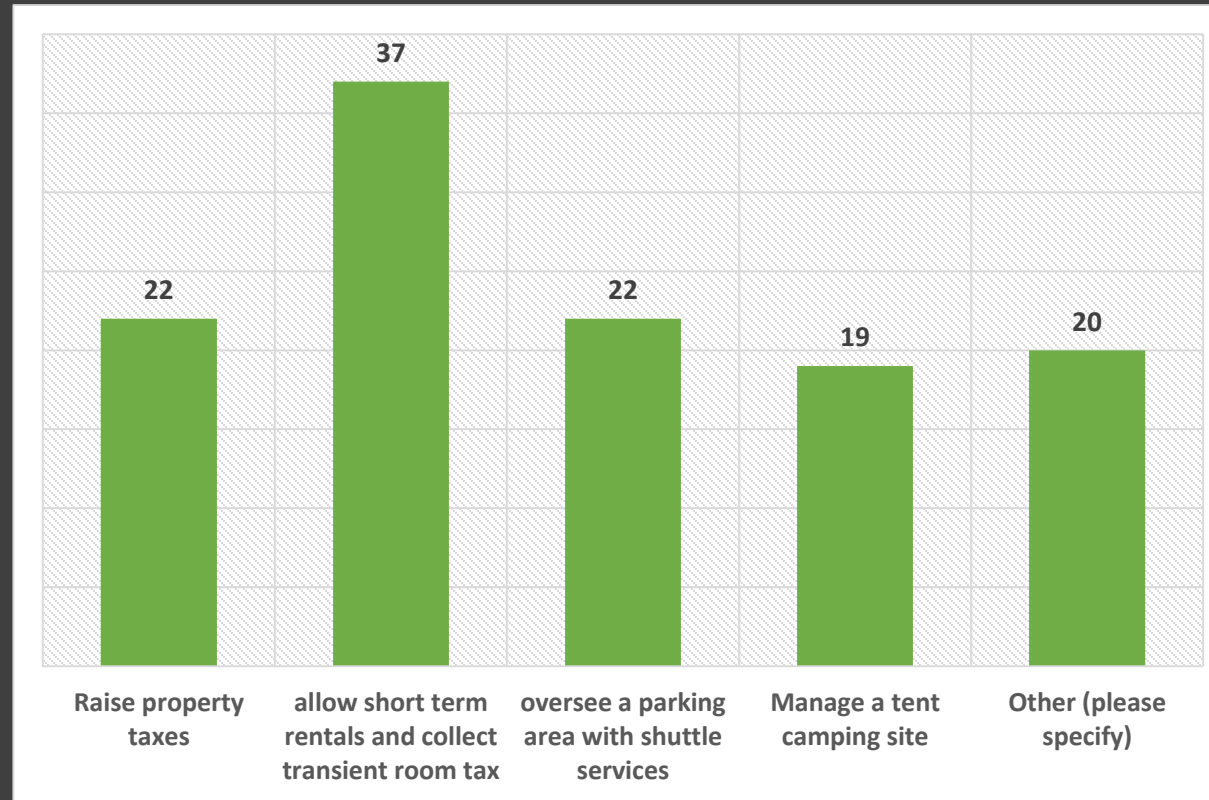

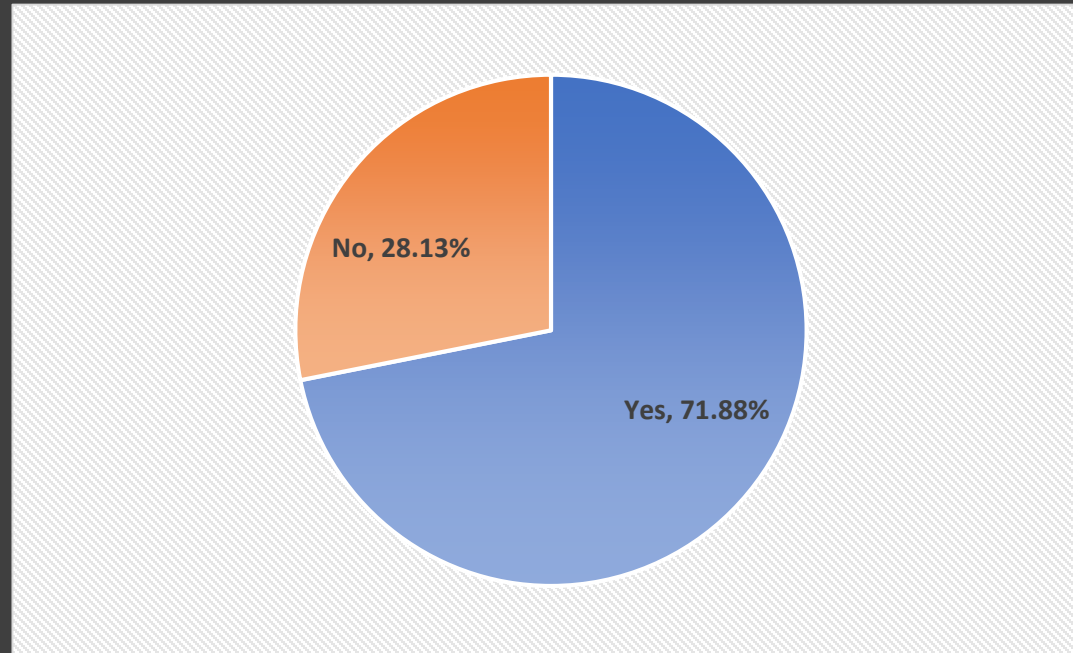

# If you do not want commercial development, how does Rockville remain solvent?



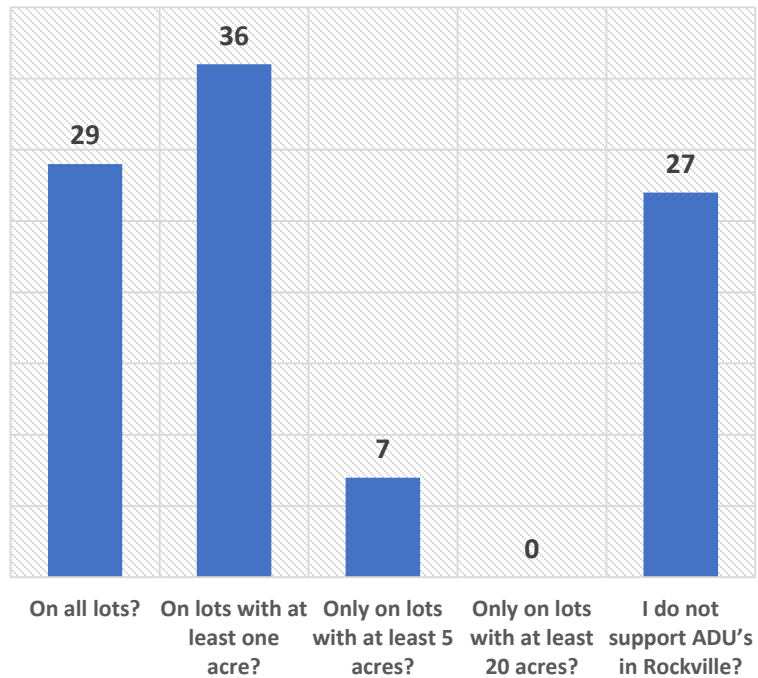


# Do you think that Rockville should allow accessory dwelling units?



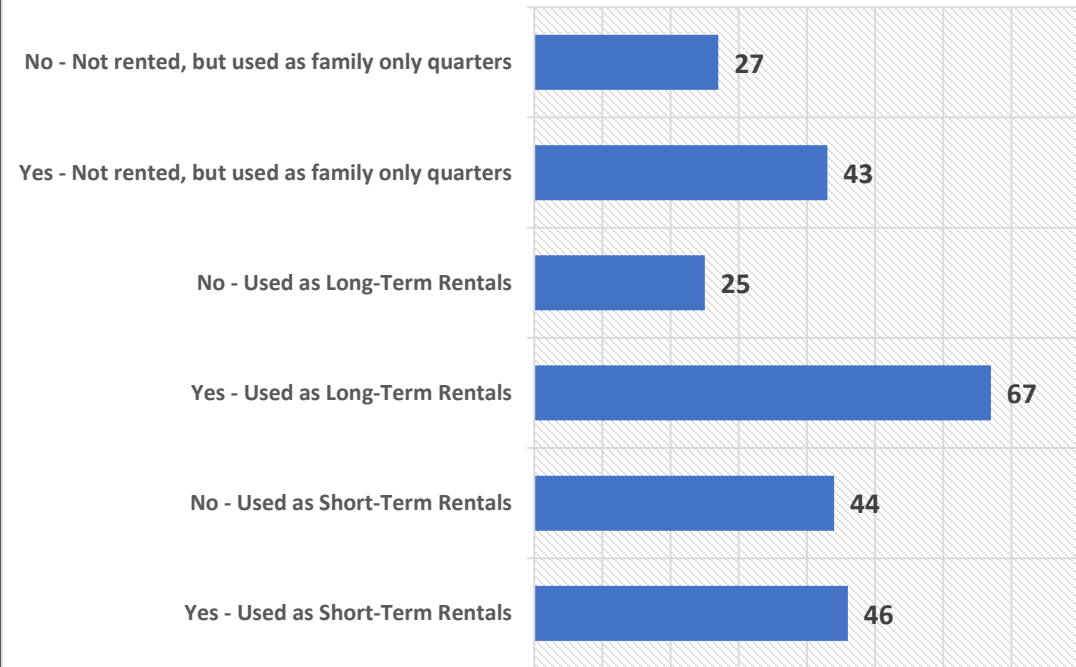

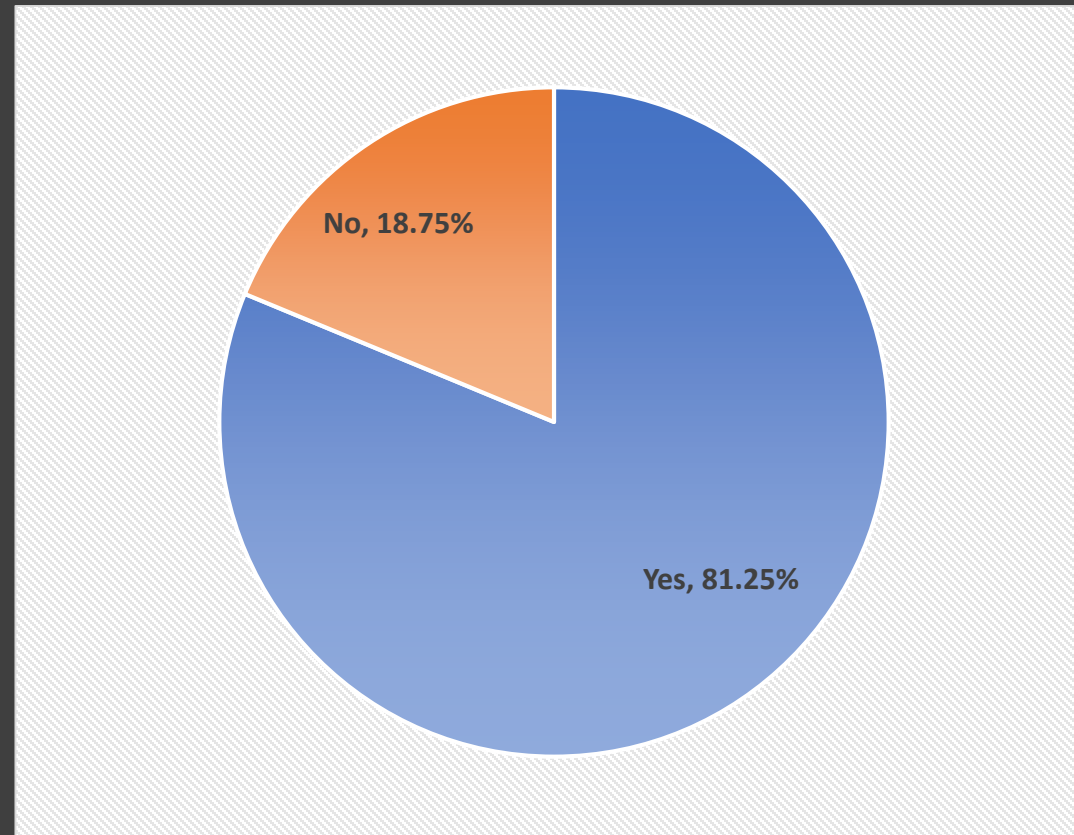

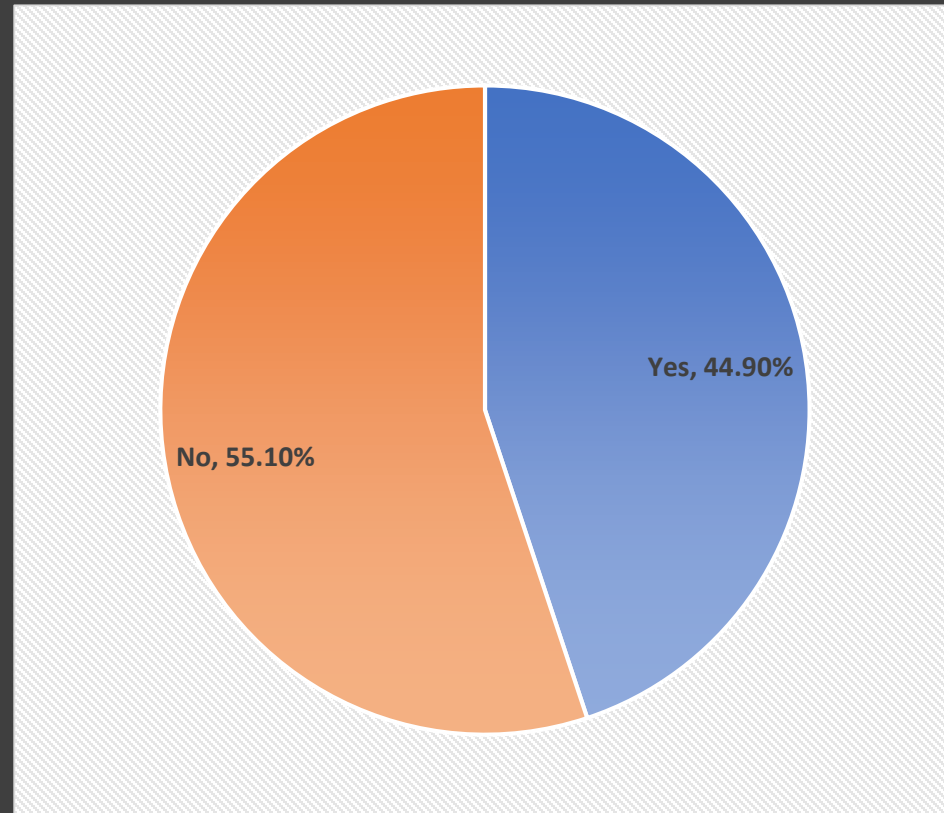

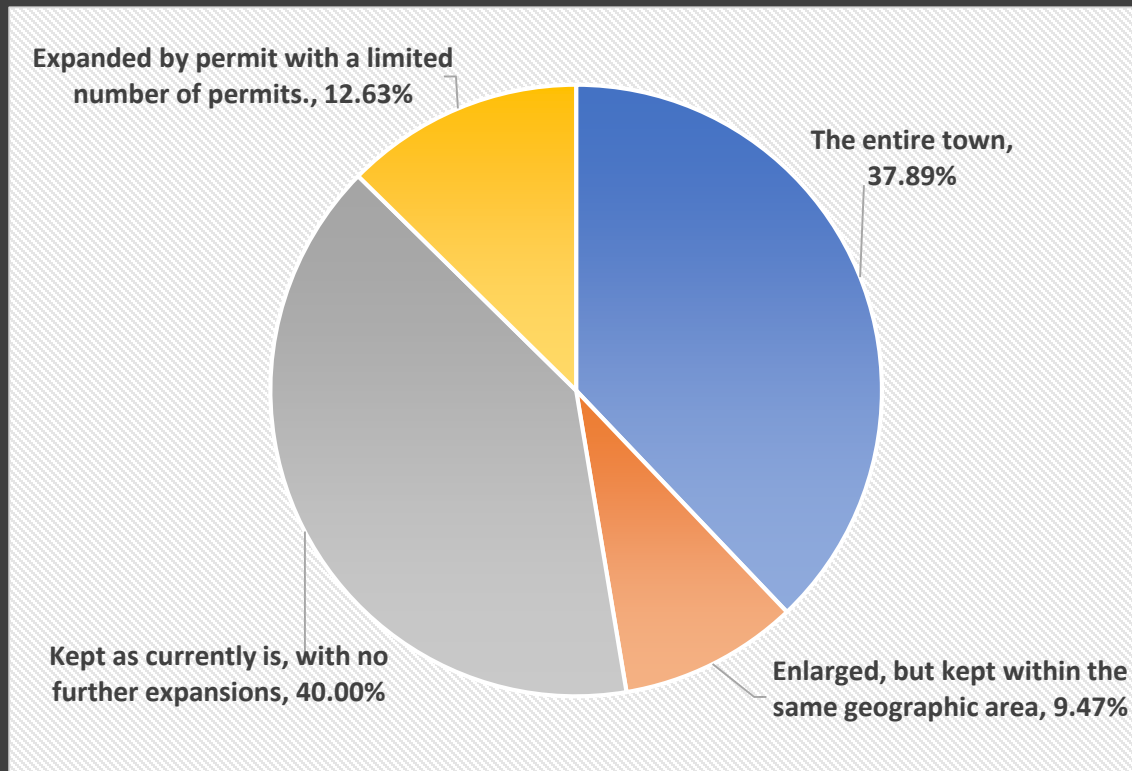
**Would you support long term rental of apartments to non-family members if the apartment was within the footprint of an existing residence?**



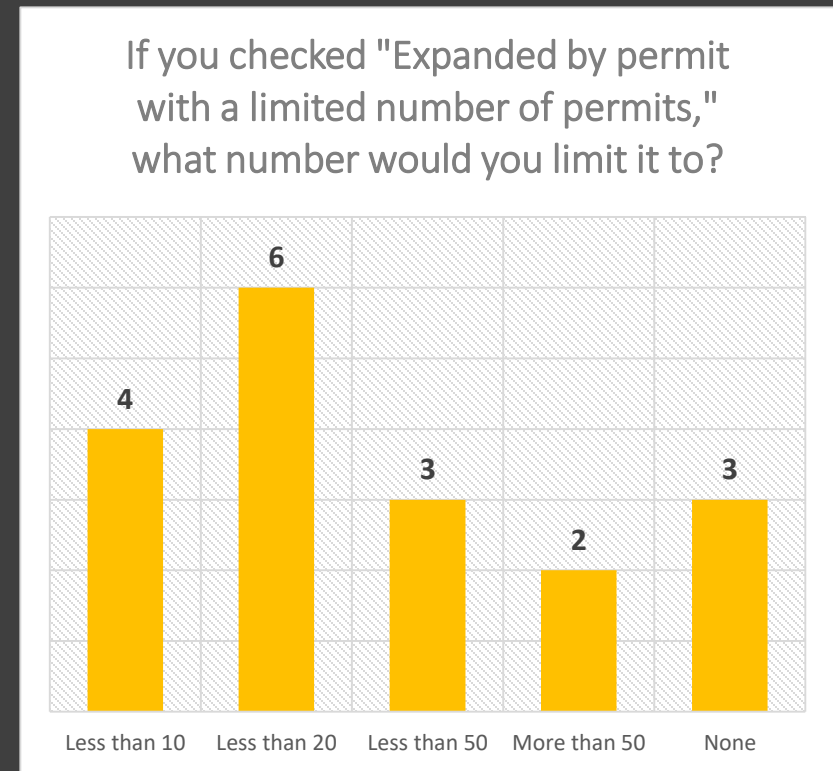
# Would you support Short Term Rentals throughout Rockville, on any parcel?



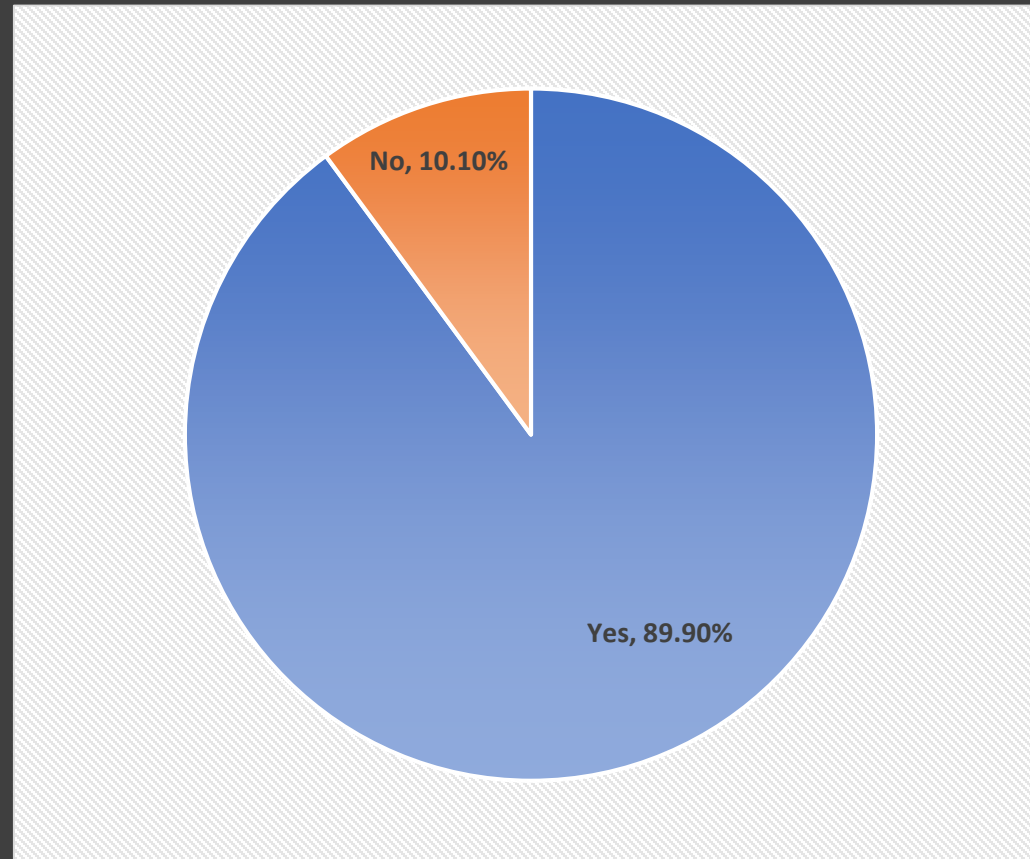
# The Town has an overlay zone which allows for short term rentals. Would you like to see that overlay zone expanded to...



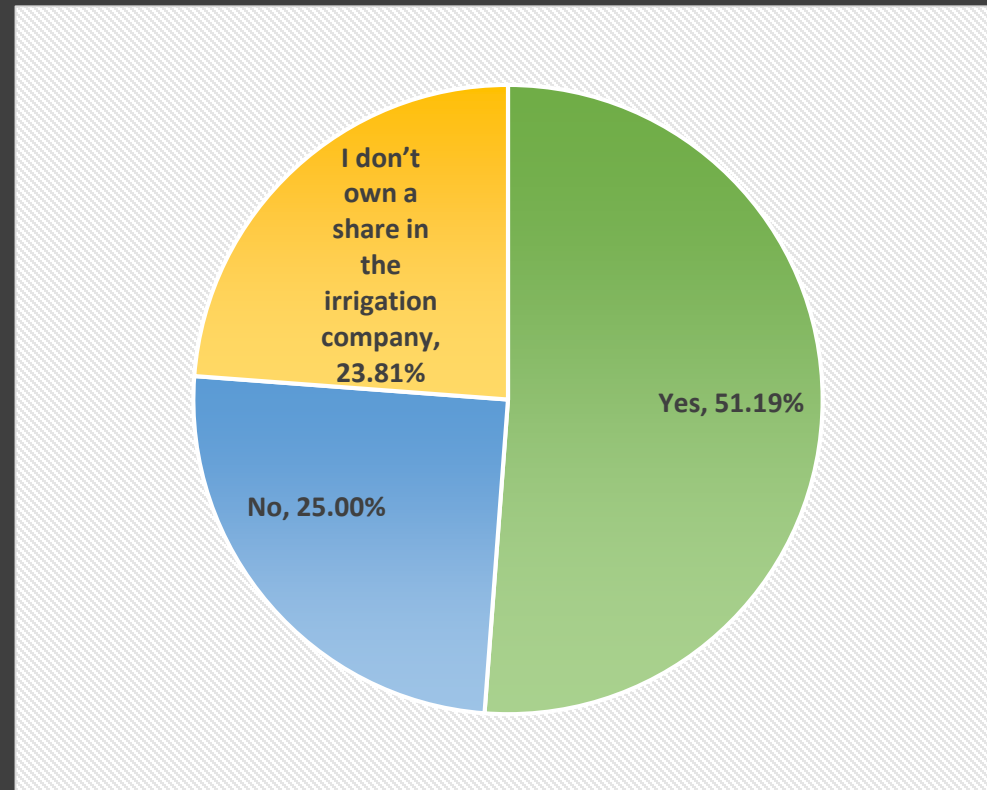

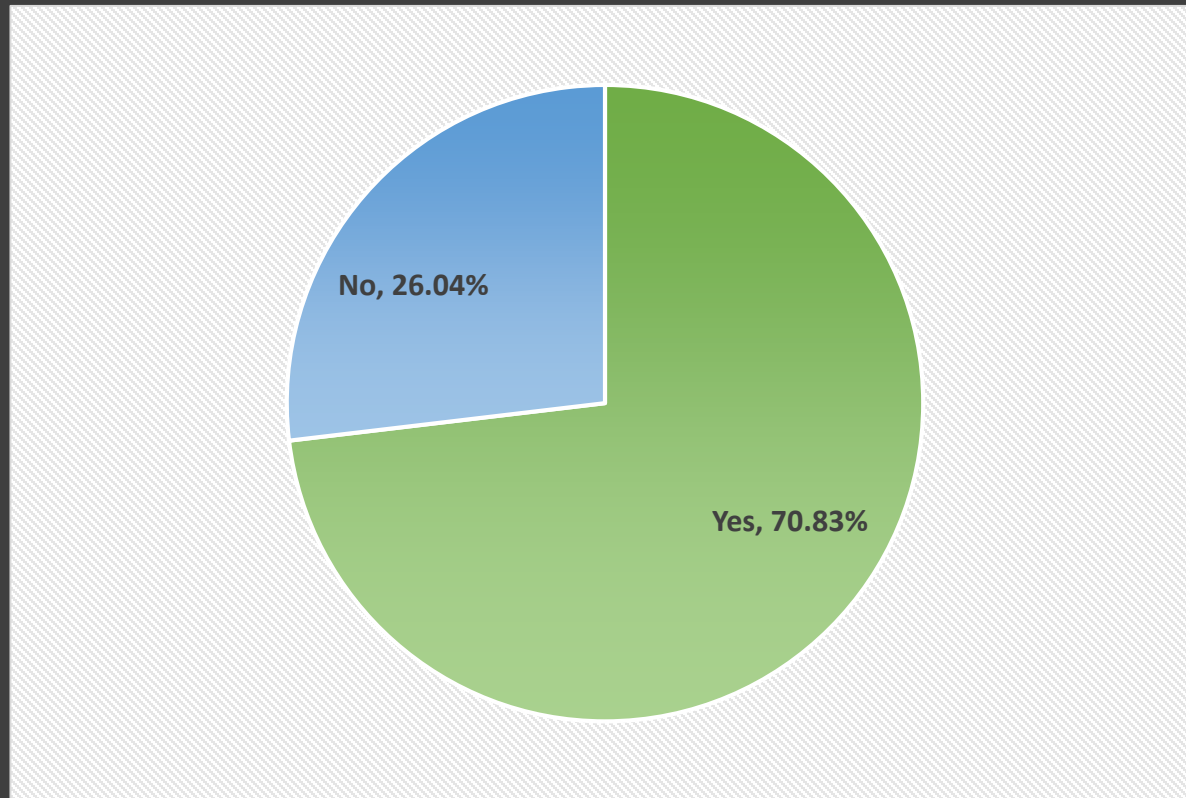
# Do you believe that water is a critical issue in our area?



**If you currently water outdoors with culinary water, are you willing to stop, or change to ditch water (if you own a share in a local irrigation company)**

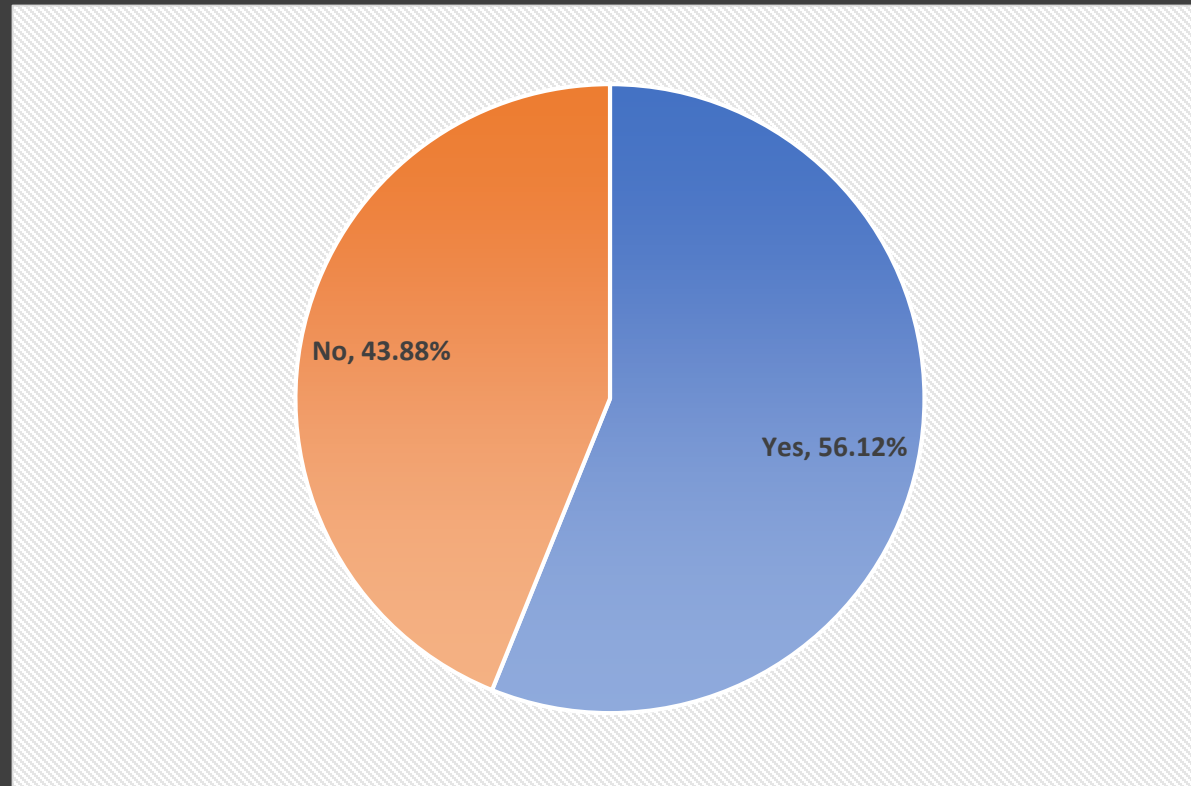


**Would you support residential water conservation methods? (E.g. Water rates that increase with increased block usage.)**

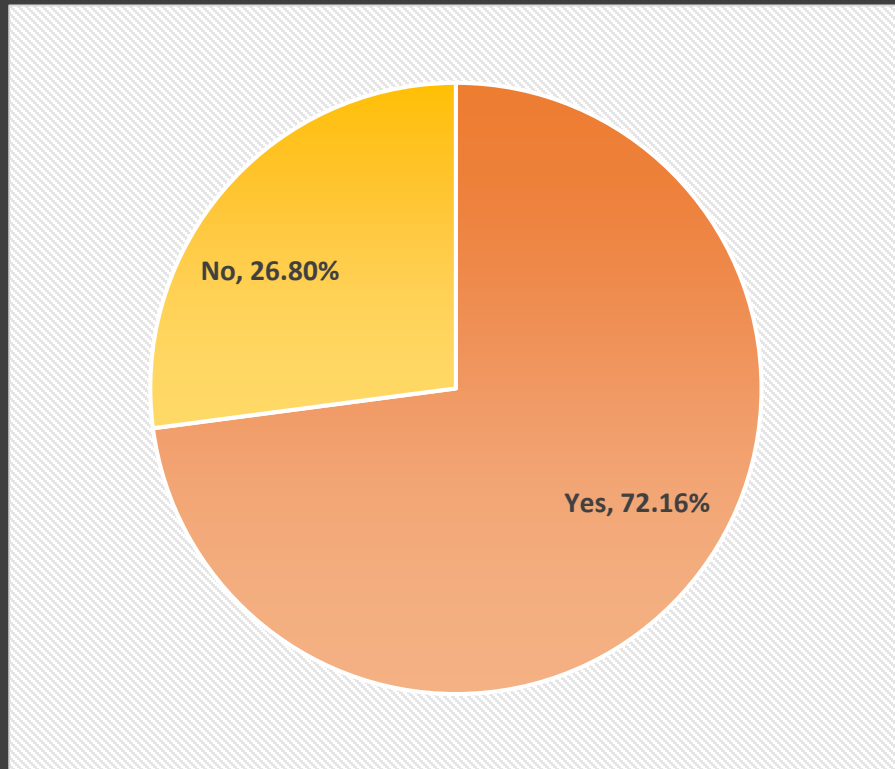




**Are you in favor of limiting the number of large farm animals according to the acreage? One large animal (horse) or three medium-size animals (goats) per half-acre in the residential zone.**

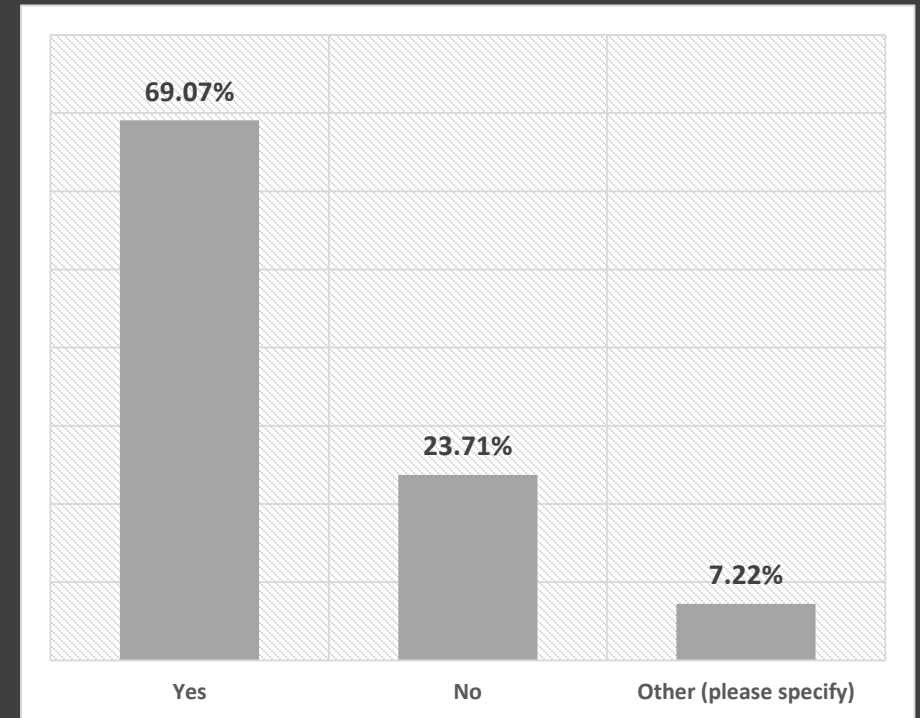


# Should the Town limit the number of dogs on a residential lot?

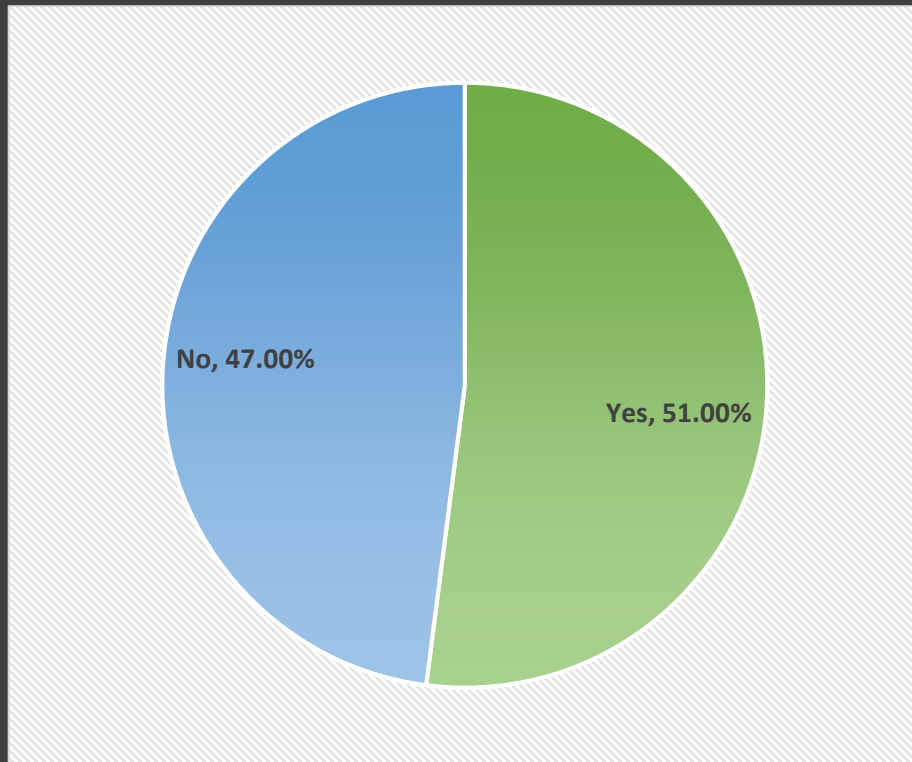
# Should Rockville require a kennel license for homes with more than four dogs?

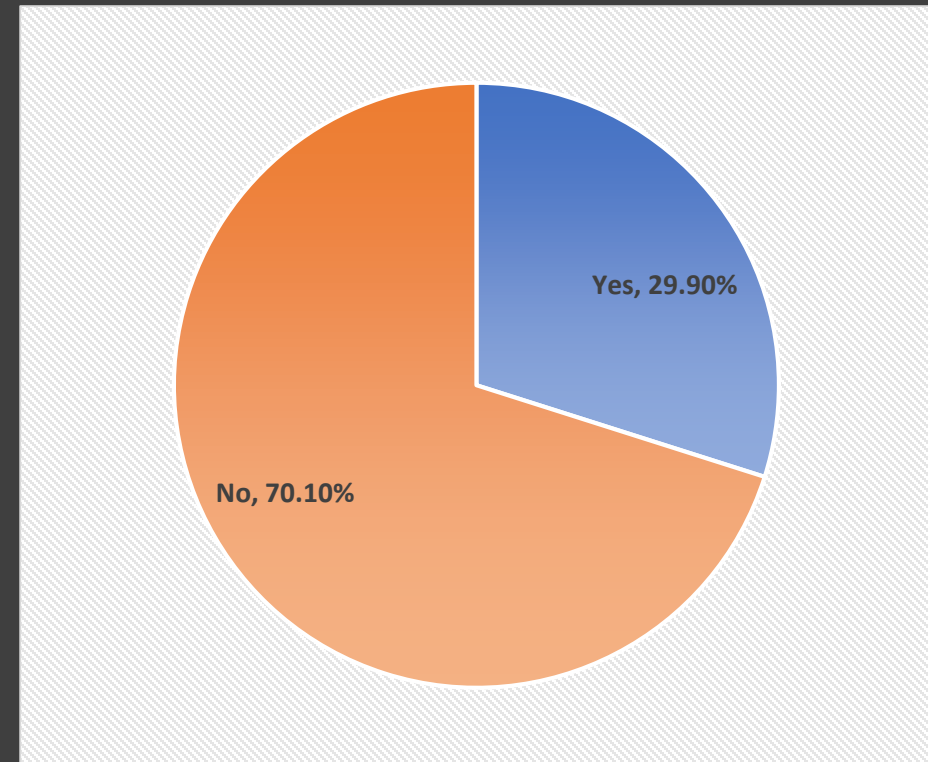

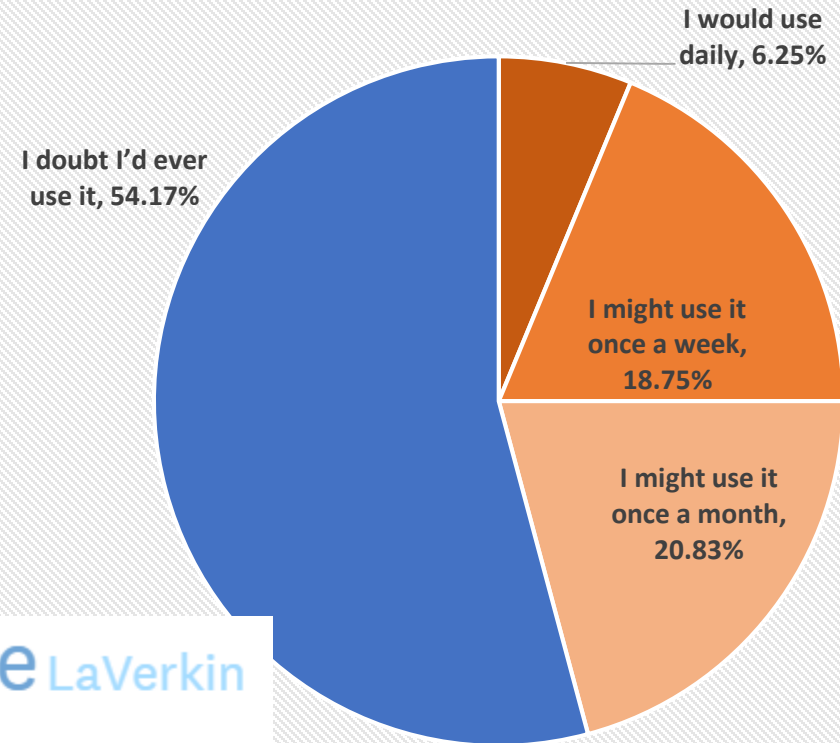


# If transit options were available in Rockville, would you use it?

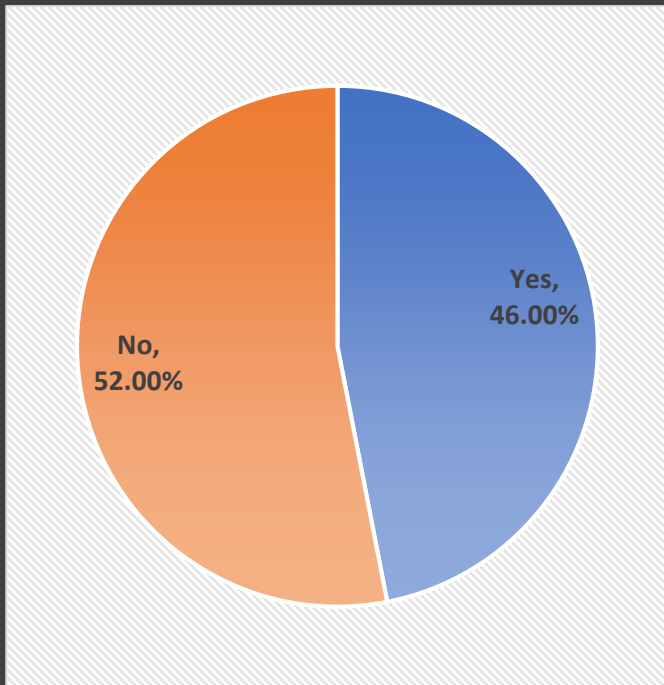

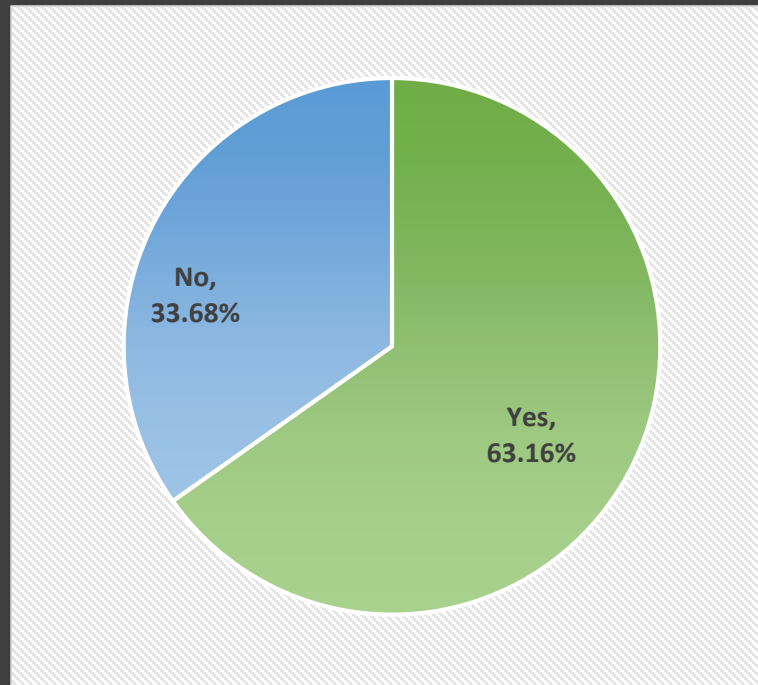

Washington County approved the purchase of 300 acres on the west end of town for the purpose of a park and ride. Do you support this?



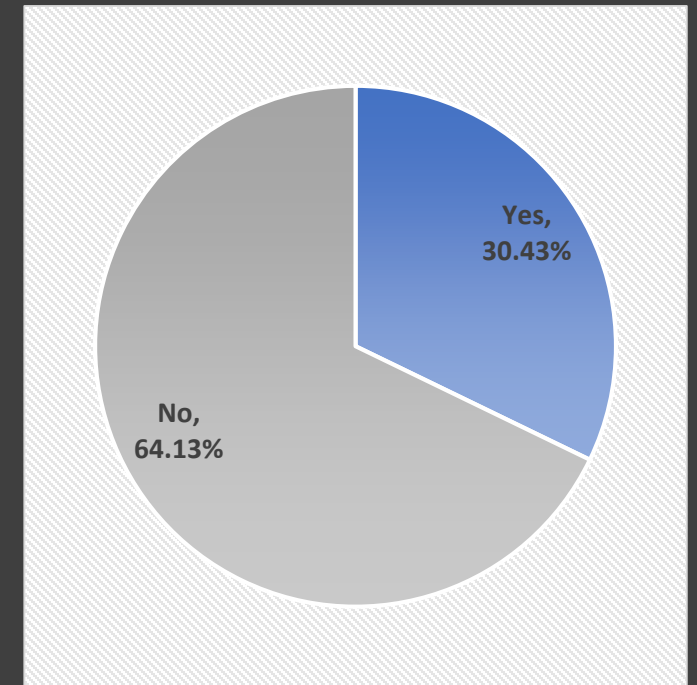
